1. Everything in the circle is what God is not. It represents heretical views.
2. All the words outside the circle represent God accurately according to Scripture.
3. The circle represent revelation; what God has reveled to man about Himself through the Scriptures.
4. Note the words opposite each other are in tension, One versus three, transcendence versus immanence and equality versus distinction.
5. Words inside the circle represent views of God through-out history. Views that the Christian church have agreed are to be considered heresy or heterodoxic. The fact that it is still a topic suggests that many in the church still grapple with the idea of a clearly defined view of the Trinity.
