- 1. Everything in the circle is what God is not. It represents heretical views.
- 2. All the words outside the circle represent God accurately according to Scripture.
- 3. The circle represent revelation; what God has reveled to man about Himself through the Scriptures.
- 4. Note the words opposite each other are in tension, One versus three, transcendence versus immanence and equality versus distinction.
- 5. Words inside the circle represent views of God through-out history. Views that the Christian church have agreed are to be considered heresy or heterodoxic. The fact that it is still a topic suggests that many in the church still grapple with the idea of a clearly defined view of the Trinity.
